We wish you all a safe and happy summer holiday of 2017.



What are the benefits of playing music?


Ivan: I have learnt patience, concentration and the importance of teamwork. Teammates' cooperation is essential when we play in a band.






6. NTJ: Octopus


7. 🗊 : Cat

15. ENTP: Parrot


















Student Voice
